DUAL DEGREE PROGRAMS: Bridge Adult Degree Completion Programs into the MPA

- Professional Studies (BA or BS) and Master of Public Administration (MPA)
- Management Studies (BS) and Master of Public Administration (MPA)

These dual-degree programs offer Management Studies and Professional Studies undergraduate students an accelerated program of study to obtain both an undergraduate degree and a Master of Public Administration degree.

- Save time and money by completing 12 graduate credits while working on your undergraduate degree
- Earn your bachelors and masters degree by completing approximately 150 credits of coursework (transfer credits are accepted)
- Can be completed 100% online or in person at our Poughkeepsie campus

Upon admission, dual-degree students take four MPA courses during their senior year (two courses each semester), and the remaining courses after completing their undergraduate degree. MPA courses are offered in two 8-week sessions during the fall and spring semesters, and one 8-week session in the summer.

MPA 506	Administrative Law
MPA 505	HR Management in Public Organizations
MPA 508	Statistics for Public Managers

The MPA Program offers five concentrations:
